

White Seabass Restoration Project

To make a difference AND spend a day in the 'Magic Kingdom', all you need to do is attend a White Seabass Volunteer Orientation, complete an independent feeding (one per person) and submit a WSB Volunteer Log. Below is all the information you need to know to get involved with our White Seabass Restoration Program. Please take a look and let me know if you have ANY questions.

Note: We currently do not have fish, as we released our last batch in November. We have, however, added you to our system and will contact you once we get a new delivery date and start to schedule orientations for our next batch of white seabass (most likely in Mid-April). We currently have two WSB grow-out facilities:

San Diego Bay (Downtown, N. Harbor & Hawthorn)

This facility consists of two pens and a floating dock that moves with the water. Individuals, pairs and groups are welcome, but must have a good sense of balance. We do not have fish at this time, but expect to receive a new batch in April.

Mission Bay (Quivira Basin, Near SeaWorld)

This facility is smaller and safer than the San Diego Bay location and is recommended for families with small children, volunteers with special needs or persons not comfortable on unstable ground. This site does not have fish at this time, but is reserved to hold potential broodstock (parent) fish for the Hubbs-SeaWorld Hatchery in Carlsbad. Volunteers will be needed for this location as soon as we receive adult fish. Status will be updated soon.
